Why should you be concerned about managing your supervisor:

- There is no/little training program for supervisors they are all trying to do their best
- They are only human
- Get a head start on being a supervisor yourself
- Your degree / your career is your responsibility

Things to Consider:

- 1. Know what you want and communicate it effectively / efficiently
- 2. Plan your time and update as needed periodically and communicate it
- 3. Engage your supervisor request regular meetings
- 4. Know your supervisor's experience level have they managed many students
- 5. Know what motivates them
- 6. Be a net asset to the supervisor, be easy to supervisor, gain their respect:
 - a. Show up to lab meetings
 - b. Be prepare
 - c. Take on reasonable extra tasks / put up your hand
 - d. Set goals / meet deadlines
 - e. Help with workshops, conferences
 - f. Help with publications
- 7. Get additional advice on as needed additional mentor, perhaps a former student of your supervisor
- 8. Know your rights as a student, know what your university expects from your supervisor
- 9. Know your departments admin staff as well as graduate studies admin staff (and get to know the janitor {:])
